- CONGREGATIONAL DELEGATES representing 35 of the 41 Ohio Conference congregations prayed, worshiped, and discussed at the Annual Assembly held at Central Christian School on March 4 and 5. Seeking guidance for future Conference direction, a resolution recommending withdrawal from Mennonite Church USA was presented for a vote. 67% affirmation was needed for passage and the percentage of affirmations was 55%. So, the Ohio Conference remains one of the 16 conferences that make up Mennonite Church USA. As from the beginning, the authority for decisions of faith and practice rests with conferences and not with MCUSA. Ohio Conference continues to fully support the 1995 Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective and holds its credentialed ministers accountable to the resolution passed by our delegate body in 2015 that our credentialed ministers will not perform a same-gender ceremony/marriage or be in a same-sex relationship themselves.
