

PASTORAL LETTER

I RECALL A TIME WHEN I WAS IN A MEETING WITH A GROUP OF ADULTS AND WE WERE GOING AROUND THE ROOM AND SHARING OUR FAITH STORIES. THIS WAS A GROUP OF ADULTS WHO HAD GROWN UP IN THE CHURCH AND WERE NOT NEW TO THE FAITH. THIS IS ALWAYS A POWERFUL EXERCISE TO HEAR STORIES OF GOD'S FAITHFULNESS AS WELL AS THE DIFFICULTIES THAT ALL OF US HAVE FACED THROUGHOUT THE COURSE OF OUR LIVES. THERE WERE TEARS SHED AND RELATIONSHIPS WERE DEEPENED AND I BELIEVE GOD WAS GLORIFIED.

AS I HAVE REFLECTED ON THAT EXPERIENCE THERE IS ONE THING THAT STANDS OUT TO ME. IN THE MIDST OF THE VULNERABILITY AND THE TRUST THAT WAS SHOWN THAT EVENING, THERE WAS ALSO A PATTERN THAT EMERGED FROM EVERYONE THAT SHARED. AS EVERYONE SHARED THEIR FAITH JOURNEY IT SEEMED THAT THE ULTIMATE MEASURING ROD WITH WHICH EVERYONE GAUGED THEIR SPIRITUAL WALK WITH THE LORD BOILED DOWN TO ONE THING: DEVOTIONS. SOME SHARED HOW AT AN EARLIER STAGE IN LIFE THEY FELT THEY WERE DOING BETTER IN THEIR FAITH BECAUSE THEY HAD A REGULAR ROUTINE OF PRAYER AND BIBLE READING. OTHERS TALKED ABOUT HOW THEY FEEL ASHAMED AND THAT THEY ARE A "BAD CHRISTIAN" BECAUSE THEY WERE NOT TAKING ENOUGH TIME TO PRAY AND READ THE BIBLE. OTHERS HUMBLY SHARED HOW THEY FOUND VITALITY IN THEIR SPIRITUAL LIFE THROUGH THEIR DAILY BIBLE READING AND PRAYER. OVER AND OVER AGAIN AS FOLKS SHARED ABOUT THEIR FAITH JOURNEY IT SEEMED THEY WERE REALLY JUST SHARING WHETHER OR NOT THEY WERE IN A GOOD ROUTINE WITH THEIR DEVOTIONAL LIFE.

NOW, BEFORE I GO ANY FURTHER IN THIS LETTER, LET ME AFFIRM THAT I BELIEVE PERSONAL DEVOTIONAL PRACTICES TO BE A CORE ASPECT OF CHRISTIAN DISCIPLESHIP. THAT BEING SAID, I THINK IT IS DANGEROUS TO ALLOW BIBLE READING AND PRAYER TO BE THE SOLE CRITERIA FOR HOW WE EVALUATE OUR SPIRITUAL JOURNEYS. JESUS AFFIRMS THAT THE TWO GREATEST COMMANDMENTS ARE TO "LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND' AND, 'LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'" THE PROPHET MICAH PUT IT THIS WAY, "WHAT DOES THE LORD REQUIRE OF YOU? TO ACT JUSTLY AND TO LOVE MERCY AND TO WALK HUMBLY WITH YOUR GOD." THESE PASSAGES AFFIRM THAT A HUMBLE, PERSONAL, LOVING WALK WITH THE LORD IS A VITAL PART OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH.

THESE PASSAGES ALSO MAKE IT EXCEEDINGLY CLEAR THAT OUR CHRISTIAN LIFE MUST BE MORE THAN JUST OUR PERSONAL DEVOTIONS. WE ARE CALLED TO BE LOVING OUR NEIGHBORS, TO LOVE MERCY AND ACTING JUSTLY. AS WE SAT AROUND THAT ROOM THAT EVENING I DIDN'T HEAR STORIES OF JUSTICE, MERCY AND LOVING NEIGHBORS AS VITAL PARTS OF THE FAITH STORIES BEING SHARED. I DON'T THINK THAT MEANS THESE THINGS WEREN'T HAPPENING, RATHER IT MEANT THAT WE DID NOT SEE LOVING NEIGHBORS AND DOING JUSTICE AS EQUALLY IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF OUR FAITH JOURNEYS. JAMES, THE BROTHER OF JESUS PUTS IT THIS WAY, "RELIGION THAT GOD OUR FATHER ACCEPTS AS PURE AND FAULTLESS IS THIS: TO LOOK AFTER ORPHANS AND WIDOWS IN THEIR DISTRESS AND TO KEEP ONESELF FROM BEING POLLUTED BY THE WORLD."

PERSONAL DEVOTIONAL PRACTICES ARE A CORE PART OF WHAT IT MEANS TO LIVE A CHRISTIAN LIFE. HOWEVER, WE MUST BE CAUTIOUS ABOUT OVER EMPHASIZING THESE PERSONAL PRACTICES AT THE EXPENSE OF LOVING OUR NEIGHBORS AND LOVING MERCY AND PURSUING JUSTICE. THE NEXT TIME SOMEONE ASKS YOU TO SHARE YOUR TESTIMONY, I ENCOURAGE YOU NOT TO JUST GIVE A REPORT OF YOUR DEVOTIONAL PRACTICES, BUT EXPAND YOUR STORY INTO THE RELIGION THAT JAMES CALLS PURE AND FAULTLESS.
