UPDATE FROM CALEB HOSTETLER'S CROSS CULTURAL IN THAILAND:

HERE ARE A FEW PICTURES FROM PHUKET, AN ISLAND PROVINCE WHERE WE SPENT THE FIRST TWO WEEKS QUARANTINING. IT WAS A VERY STRANGE TIME - IT FELT MORE LIKE A VACATION THAN A CROSS CULTURAL. BUT WE STILL DID SOME LANGUAGE AND CULTURE CLASSES, AND WE HAD A LOT OF TIME TO GROW AND BOND AS A GROUP. AFTER THOSE TWO WEEKS, WE MOVED TO OUR "PERMANENT" HOME IN CHIANG MAI, A CITY IN NORTHERN THAILAND. WE ARE STAYING AT A YMCA, WHICH, UNLIKE A YMCA IN THE STATES, IS MORE LIKE A COMMUNITY OUTREACH CENTER THAN A REC CENTER. THEY HAVEN'T BEEN ABLE TO DO A WHOLE LOT DURING COVID, BUT OUR BEING THERE HAS HELPED GIVE THEM SOME BUSINESS THEY HAVE BEEN MISSING. THIS IS ALSO WHERE WE HAVE BEEN TAKING THAI LANGUAGE, CULTURE, AND HISTORY CLASSES. WE HAVE STARTED TO SETTLE INTO MORE OF A ROUTINE - WEEKDAYS USUALLY CONSIST OF ACTIVITIES AT THE YMCA FROM 7AM-2PM, AND THEN WE HAVE THE EVENINGS FREE TO OURSELVES. SOME POPULAR ACTIVITIES INVOLVE ORDERING FOOD, GOING TO THE NEARBY GYM, TAKING WALKS AROUND THE CITY, OR WALKING AROUND THE MALLS (WHICH ARE WAY MORE FUN AND POPULAR THAN THEY ARE IN THE STATES)!
