Building on its original mission of providing housing and services for older adults, the Manor has continued as a not-for-profit ministry to provide lower cost housing for persons in need. The 17-unit apartment building (9652 Akron Rd, Rittman) is owned by Crown Hill Mennonite Church and operated by a nine-person volunteer Board of Directors.

Board meetings are held at the Manor monthly, on the second Thursday at 6:30 PM. We are looking for a Board member who enjoys being part of a team and would be interested in using their skills in this ministry of providing housing. A current need is for someone who could serve as Board secretary, but that would not be required.

The day-to-day operations of the Manor depend on volunteer labor and services hired as needed. Management of rentals and interior maintenance is provided by Board member Floyd Fawcett. Management of grounds is provided by Board member Travis Miller.
