**Preaching: Thomas** 

**Sermon: Light in the Valley** 

Scripture: Psalm 23, Ephesians 5:8-14

The Crown Hill Leadership Team spent a large portion of our meeting discussing the process and results of the ACA vote in which the majority of Ohio Conference delegates voted to disaffiliate from MCUSA, but not the 66% needed to pass the vote. This is a time of uncertainty for all of Ohio Conference as Conference leadership and individual congregations seek to understand what this majority, but not passing, vote means.

Here is how Conference Minister Dick Barrett wrote his thoughts: "We live in a country which prides itself on the democratic process, and as Anabaptists and Mennonites the process of communal decision making is very important, but church is not a democracy. Church is a theocracy with the triune God of Father, Son and Holy Spirit as the head. Voting can be a tool that helps us discern God's will and to make decisions together, but in making large and important decisions that affect the future of the church, God's will should be clearer than just a majority. And as much as many among us would like to be done with the question of affiliation and be moving on, we need to remember

that we live in God's timing which is often different than our own. How might God be speaking to us in this time we are in? Is there a better way, or as Anabaptists and Mennonites like to say, "Is there a third way?" Is God calling us to something different that we have not yet fully explored? These are questions that we are going to need to try to answer as we continue to discern together in the second year of our review process facilitated by our consultant, Jeanne Zimmerly Jantzi. I am confident that if we remain faithful to the process, and we continue to love one another in the same way we have throughout this first year, God will reveal his will for us as a conference for the years ahead. "Because of our partnership in the gospel he who began a good work in us will carry it on to completion."

The Leadership team discussed at length what our next steps should be as a church. We understand that the clear majority of our people desired to disaffiliate with MCUSA. We know that there are some in Crown Hill who believe that we as a church should now leave Ohio Conference and we know there are some that are content to stay with Ohio Conference so long as Ohio Conference continues to adhere to article 19 in the Confession of Faith regarding Human Sexuality.

The Leadership Team is planning a way to hear input from the congregation in the near future. Stay tuned for next steps in that process. In the meantime let's all keep praying together that we can be faithful to God as we discern together.
