Greetings from Honduras! These two months have been very full. We continue to repair and improve upon the base's property. We were able to facilitate a Kairos course in San Pedro Sula, held a mission conference with a youth group from a local Anabaptist church, and had a retreat for two churches who were taking Alpha. It has been so neat to do ministry like this as a couple and connect with other couples in this way. Austin continues to preach at several churches as well as connect with other ministry leaders.

Austin shared "Something I have thought over the past 9 years as I've been in and out of Central America: why would God choose me for this? Occasionally I feel homesick as I think back to the life I left behind or even of opportunities I could have had in the U.S., both professionally and with family. However, a few weeks ago I was able to have lunch with a gringo guy, Isaac, who's been serving at an orphanage here for the past three months and is heading back to the US. He shared that seeing me serve has encouraged him to follow God's ministry call He has placed on his life. When I hear testimonies like that, it encourages me to keep going and follow God's call that I am positive He's put on my life!"

Gris continues connecting with ladies that come to the base and started El Nido sessions with her first client! Gris is very excited about this chance to impact mothers and can definitely see God's hand in the encounter! Gris said "I was heading back to the base on a mototaxi and was asking God what to do to connect with pregnant mothers. In that moment I looked and the lady sitting beside me just happened to be a young pregnant lady! I asked her name; she said it was Ana. I asked if she would be willing to join El Nido and she said she was looking for a program like it. She has really opened up her heart to me and I am excited to see what God does through this relationship and the start of El Nido here!"

Thank you again for being apart of this through your prayer and finances. We are so grateful! We are well aware that we would not be able to do this without you! Thank you for choosing to mobilize the Honduran church!

Pray for:

- 1) That we can keep our marriage relationship the priority during a lot of ministry and movement.
- 2) For full funding! We are at about 75% of our monthly goal but are still looking for more financial partners.
- 3) For the hearts of the church members who have heard us talk about God's mission to be flamed to be involved in His mission.

- 5) That God would give Gris wise words for the mothers coming to El Nido.
- 6) For Gris' visa to be approved so that we can go to the U.S. in June.
- 7) The 20 pastors and leaders who will be taking ILI (International Leadership Insitute) at the base. Pray that this time encourages them to seek intimacy with Jesus! This will be the first one we lead. If you would like to sponsor one of them to take the course (\$12), let Austin know.
