Two Stories Of Generosity:

In December of 2022 the Crown Hill Leadership Team and the leaders of the Food Pantry decided to purchase a used box truck that was available at White's Maibach Ford in Orrville. Thus far this has been a helpful purchase for the Food Pantry and it has been put to good use. In the June Leadership Team meeting, Delmar reported on the Food Pantry finances for the first half of the year. As the LT was reading through this report one of the members asked about an unusually large donation that came through in February. Delmar shared that this was an anonymous donation that covered the entire cost of the truck that the church purchased! What a blessing. Thank you to the anonymous person who made this donation!

A little while back at The Manor, one of the residents had a medical emergency and called 911 from their room. When the first responders arrived they were not able to locate the master key of the building so they had to break down the door to this person's apartment to treat them. Thankfully the resident was OK and has recovered from the medical emergency. However, the door that the first responders had to break down was a fire door that retails for upwards of \$2,600! Floyd did a good job of shopping around and found a door that sold at a more reasonable price. Meanwhile, Pastor Todd Martin from Smithville Mennonite heard about the situation because the resident at the Manor who called 911 is a member at Smithville Mennonite. Smithville Mennonite then made a donation to The Manor that covered the cost of a new door and then some!
