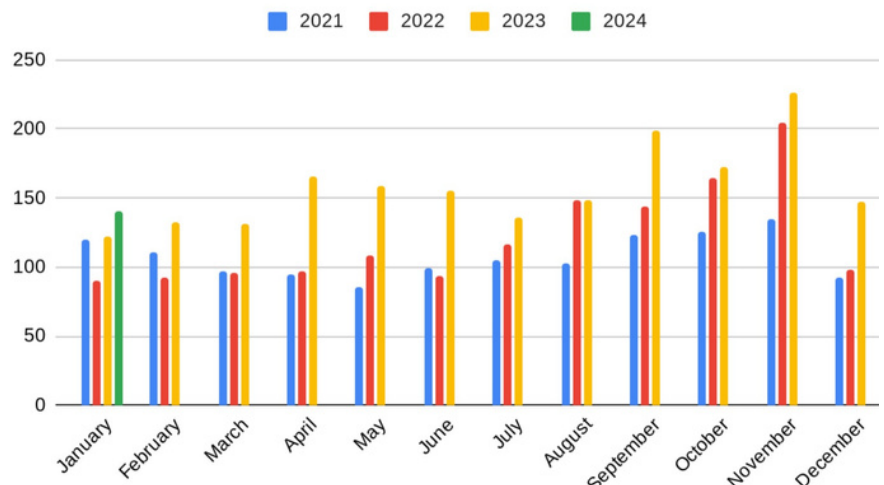
- Remember the unspoken requests for families in our congregation
