- Worship begins at 10am at Camp Luz, 152 Kidron Rd, Orrville, OH 44667
 - We will be worshipping on the chapel lawn.
 - The camp will have some canopies set up to provide shade, but some people will inevitably be sitting in the sun. Bring broad brim hats and sunscreen for sun protection.
 - Salem will provide some metal folding chairs for worship seating, though people are encouraged to bring their own lawn chairs for more comfortable seating.
