Many of our neighbors receive Snap/EBT, Food Stamps, from the Department of Job & Family Services. As this is a government agency they are temporarily suspending the program due to the government shutdown. We at Love Inc. are reaching out to you, the churches of Wayne Co. to meet this, hopefully, temporary need. If you would consider purchasing Walmart Gift cards that could then be given to families to purchase groceries, we will do the vetting and communicating with clients. Family friendly gift cards that may not be used to purchase alcohol, tobacco, firearms, or lottery tickets are available online, and then must be used in store. We will also be sending out Food Pantry directories to any neighbors who call in for food assistance.
